Minter Creek is one of the largest streams on the Key Peninsula and contains ESA listed winter steelhead and non-listed coho, fall chum and coastal cutthroat trout. The proposed grant will fund the design of a new crossing to replace the existing 10 ft. x 6 ft concrete box culvert to restore fish passage. This project will benefit from the downstream WSDOT SR 302 fish barrier removal project, scheduled for 2021 construction.

This project was not identified in the Key Peninsula-Islands Basin Plan (2006). In 2000, the Pierce Conservation District completed a barrier inventory in the KGI watershed and this crossing was thought to be 100% passable using the survey criteria available at the time. Since that time, WDFW has updated their inventory criteria and this crossing is now deemed a partial barrier that is 67% passable. The next fish passage barrier upstream is approximately 2.5 miles upstream in Kitsap County on Pine Road.
